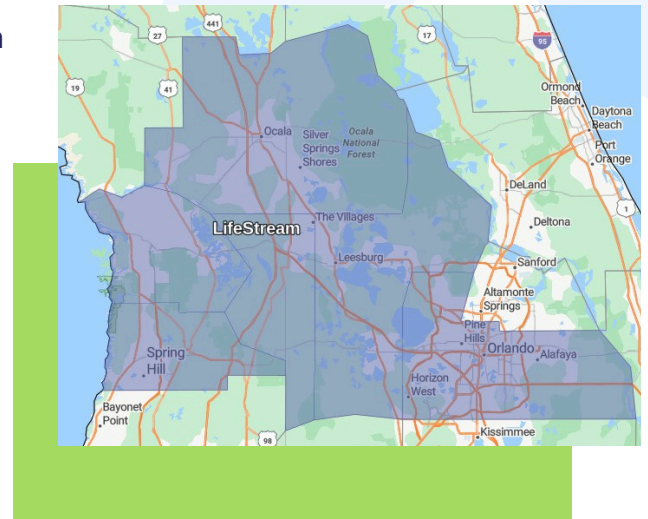

LifeStream Behavioral Center began its work in the community in 1969 as part of Waterman Memorial Hospital in Eustis, Florida, and became an independent nonprofit organization in 1971. Since then, it has expanded to operate 35 locations offering over 60 programs aimed at supporting individuals facing mental illness and substance use challenges. LifeStream serves residents across Central Florida, primarily in Lake, Citrus, and Sumter counties, with additional programs in Orange, Marion, and Hernando counties .

LifeStream is proud to be a CARF-accredited organization, currently holding a Three-Year Accreditation for our behavioral health programs from the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF), the international accrediting body. 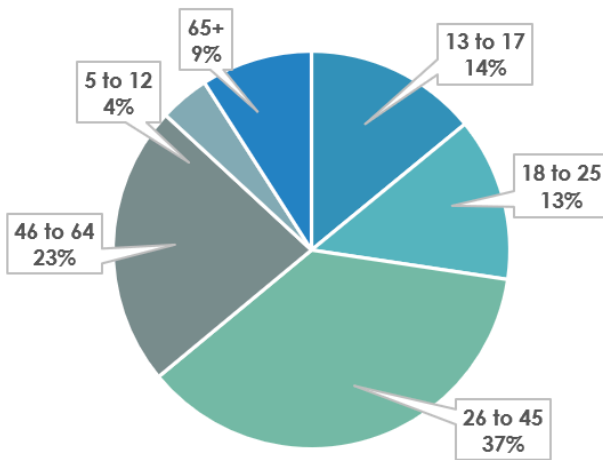

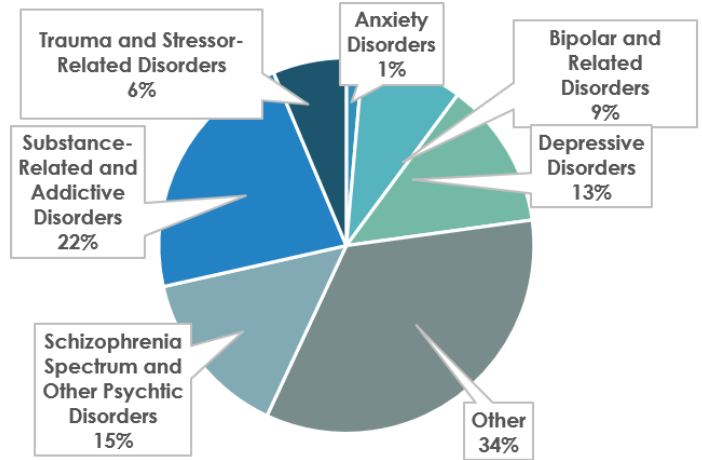

Children's Clinical On-Site Services



After my three grandchildren experienced a traumatic situation with their mother, I knew they needed more than just the love and support of family. Through a referral, we connected with LifeStream, and while I was initially nervous about the process, those fears quickly faded when we met Chelsea, a LifeStream therapist.

From our very first session, Chelsea brought warmth, compassion, and reassurance not only to my granddaughter, but to me as well. She guided us through difficult moments with kindness and helped create a safe space for healing.

Psychiatric Outpatient Services

Anthony House

When Sarah entered Anthony House, she was struggling with opioid addiction and had recently been prescribed Suboxone. Her young child was in foster care, and the court was considering terminating her parental rights. She was overwhelmed, discouraged, and caught in a cycle of unhealthy relationships.

Over time, Sarah began to trust her therapist and the team at Anthony House. She worked closely with her case manager, became more engaged in treatment, and gained the confidence to secure employment at a local restaurant. Through her hard work and determination, she was able to convince the court to reinstate a reunification case plan and began rebuilding her life.

What started as brief supervised visits with her son gradually progressed to unsupervised visits, and by the time she graduated from the program, reunification was actively being pursued. Sarah also utilized a housing grant but chose to enter a step down program rather than move directly into an apartment, allowing her to continue building stability, strengthen her relationship with her son, and save for the future.

Today, Sarah remains connected with the Anthony House team and continues to thrive. She has overnight visitation with her son, and full reunification is within reach. Her story is a powerful example of recovery, resilience, and the life changing impact of hope and support.

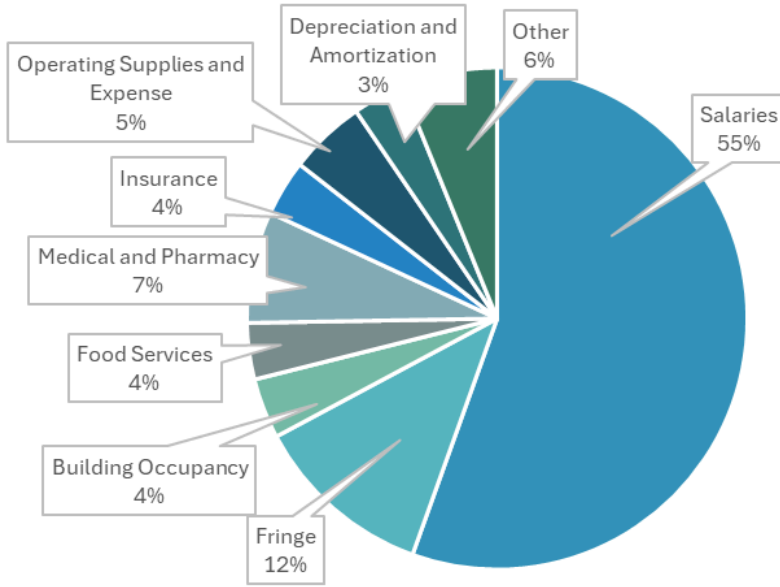

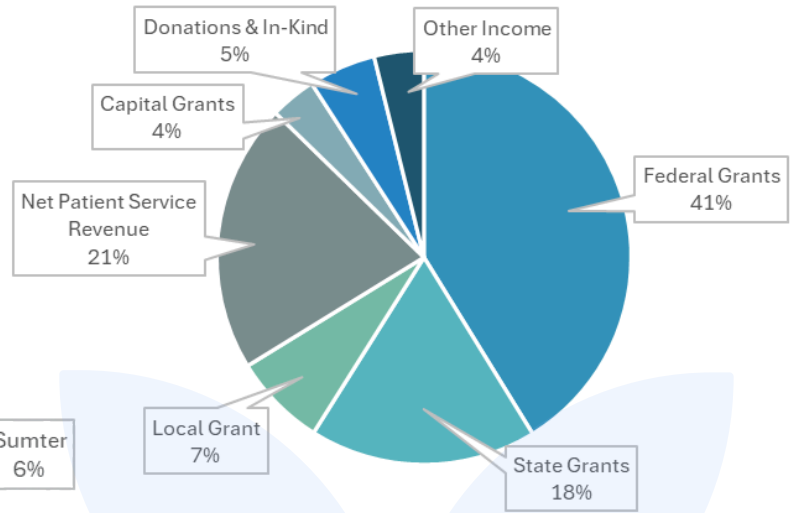

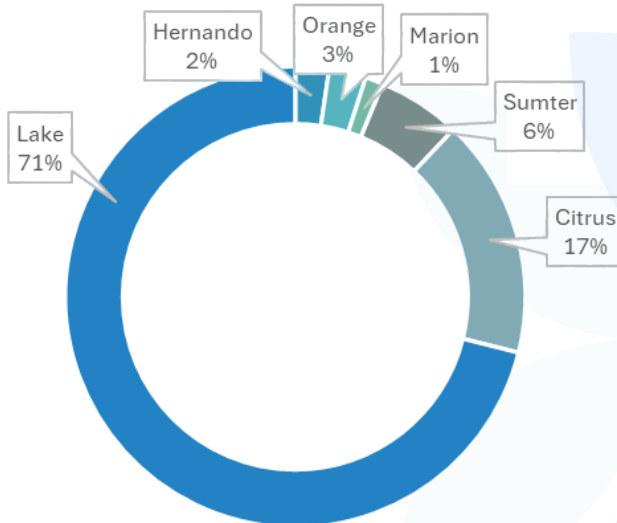
Expenses

Citrus Behavioral Health Building

LifeStream continues to make significant progress on the new Citrus Behavioral Health Building in Lecanto. Construction remains on schedule, with no delays reported, and the project is expected to open in the first quarter of calendar year 2027.

Once completed, the 60-bed facility will expand access to behavioral health services and strengthen the continuum of care for individuals and families throughout Citrus and Hernando Counties. This investment reflects LifeStream's ongoing commitment to increasing access to high quality behavioral healthcare and meeting the growing needs of the communities we serve.
